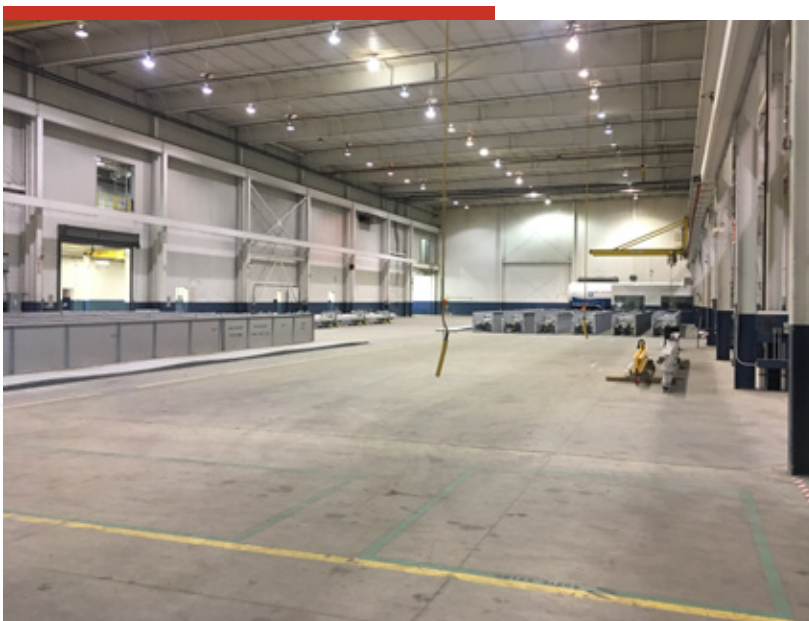

PHASE 1

Risk Assessment and Discovery

To get started, we'll want to get real about what creating a factory entails. We'll begin with a series of questions for you that will help you measure twice and cut once. This may also include a site visit. After risks are clear, we'll do a detailed discovery of your goals and expectations, finances, and other resources. By this time you'll have a good feel for the challenge and the journey ahead.

PHASE 2

Budget and Framework

After we've asked the tough questions and sized up the situation, we'll draft a detailed budget and an overall factory floorplan. This will include production line and module production flow details, as well as total acreage use including completed module staging and departure roadways.

PHASE 3 Equipment and Systems

All your equipment needs will be specified—from crane systems and jigs to tools and compressors. This will include model numbers and costs for all equipment, tools, and power needs at each station, as well as related drawings.

PHASE 4 Factory Operation Work Scope

You'll get recommendations on how each station should function. This includes estimated staff required and scope of work, as well as estimated labor hours per module per station. We'll identify storage yards or lots for completed modules. We can also provide job descriptions for technical and management positions, as well as quality control and work-progress documentation. One or more site visits are likely during this phase.

PHASE 5 Professional Services Alignment

Our team has worked with many of the top engineering, architecture, operations, purchasing, staffing, business development, and other professionals with specific experience in modular. We normally don't provide these services directly. But we will share recommendations for partners, tips on staffing a management team, and proven best practices for successful day-to-day operation and growth. We want you to succeed!
